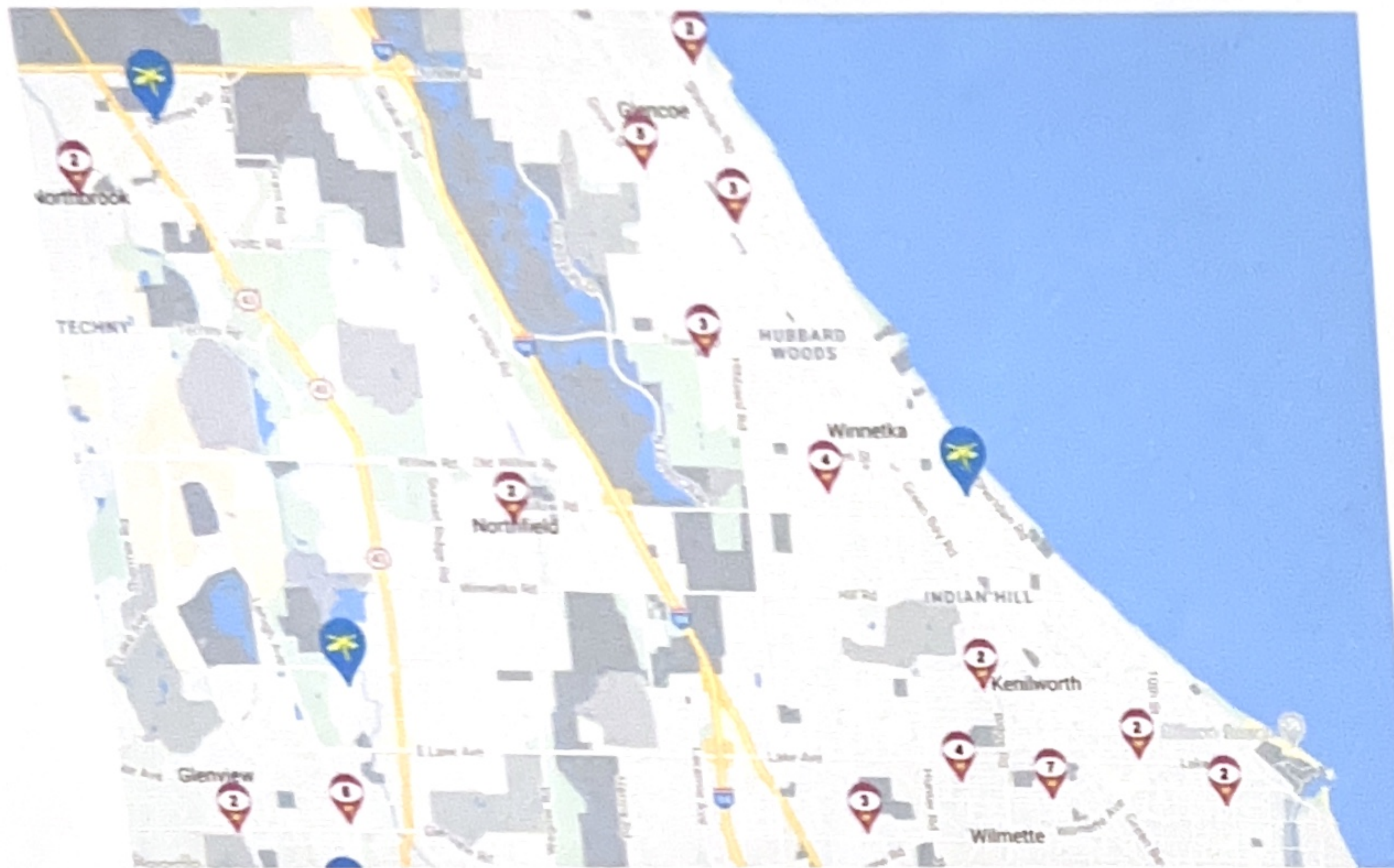


GET ON THE MAP!
